

How iTransit Works



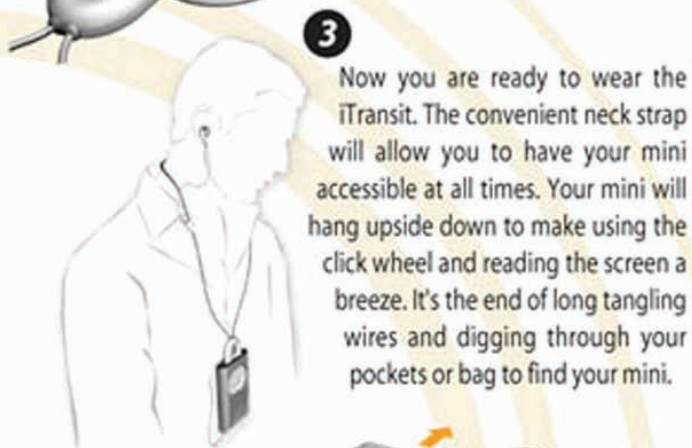

Place your iPod* mini in its protective hard plastic case. Close the case to safely seal in your mini. Slide the case into the connector. Your mini is now secured in the plastic case and locked to the connector.

Insert the headphone plug, extending from the connector, into your mini, through the headphone jack hole located at the bottom right corner of the case.

Now you are ready to wear the iTransit. The convenient neck strap will allow you to have your mini accessible at all times. Your mini will hang upside down to make using the click wheel and reading the screen a breeze. It's the end of long tangling wires and digging through your pockets or bag to find your mini.

You're just about ready to enjoy listening to your music. Simply, place the earphones in your ears. Notice that the earphones extend directly from the neck strap and the wiring is built into the neck strap. When you are not wearing the earphones, let them dangle around your neck. You are completely hands free!

When you are ready to call it a day, press down on the release button to separate the case from the connector.

Opening the case is simple. Place your pointer finger behind one of the small plastic tabs, pulling towards you, and use your thumb to push against the large plastic tab. Open the case, and the mini is free again.
